Kindergarten Program

Our small, intimate kindergarten classes provide a warm and nurturing environment for students to learn. A wide variety of educational activities expose the children to a broad range of educational experiences. The kindergarten uses a biblically based curriculum that includes the A Bekah phonics based language approach. Kindergartners also attend weekly special area classes in physical education, music and art to compliment their educational experience. Students may enroll in Half-day or Full-day programs. Senior High Program

Students enrolled in grades 9-12 have a wide variety of classes with differing degrees of rigor from which to choose. LCA uses a combination of quality resources produced by Apologia, Chicago Press, Christian Schools International, Summit Ministries, Educators Publishing Service, and Bob Jones University Press. Areas of instruction are supplemented with quality novels, projects and teacher-created units. One of the academic goals for our graduates is to have a great range of choices available to them upon graduation, and not be limited by their choices during their high school experience. A number of school approved *Advanced Placement*, *Dual Credit*, and *On-line* courses are available as well. Students may be involved with Christian Assemblies and Student Council. The arts, athletics and clubs round out the complete student experience. Areas of class instruction for credit include:
